SAT INFORMATION

All Juniors will have the opportunity to take the SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test), a college entrance exam, on March 24, 2021 in person at MBA. Juniors can look at their PSAT score reports by going to **collegeboard.org**. If you can't remember your username or password, don't guess, click on forgot username, forgot password (let us know if you have any trouble with this and we can help you!) Juniors can link their CollegeBoard accounts to Khan Academy (satpractice.org), in order to receive personalized SAT practice online. JUNIORS IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU REMEMBER YOUR USERNAMES AND PASSWORDS, so please put them in your phone!

SAT PREPARATION

There are several ways to prepare and study for the SAT. One way is to link collegeboard with Khan Academy for a personalized tutorial on the computer, as referenced above. Metropolitan also has a free SAT tutor, Mr. Peterhansel, who runs an after school SAT club. Please email him at tyler.peterhansel@new-haven.k12.ct.us if you are interested. The junior teachers have also planned SAT Prep during Advisory in the upcoming weeks, until the test. In addition, students can purchase an SAT preparatory book from a local bookstore and work from the book at their own pace.

COLLEGE EXPLORATION

Normally, Juniors would be participating in the College Fair Consortium at the Floyd Little Athletic Center, but NHPS will not be having that this year. Instead, you should attend the 2021 Hartford National College Fair virtually. There will also be upcoming virtual college fairs depending on your interests.
